

“Fire” refers to zones around the building. “1” is a 3 ft. zone next to it. “2” is the zone up to 30 ft. away. “3” is the zone from 30 ft. to 200 ft.

<i>Agave schidigera</i> ‘Shira ito no Oh!’ Queen of White Thread-Leaf agave To 1 ft. high, 2 ft. wide Flowers seldom; dark green leaves with cream-white edges.	<i>Cercis occidentalis</i> California or western redbud To 10–18 ft. tall. Pink flowers, spring. Magenta seed pods. Blue-green 3 in. leaves.	<i>Geranium x cantabrigiense</i> ‘Crystal Rose’ cranesbill To 12 in. high, 18 in. wide Rose pink flowers, spring, summer, fall; mid-green leaves turn orange
<i>Ajuga</i> ‘Black Scallop’ bugleweed, carpet bugle To 6 in. high, 12 in. wide Blue flowers, spring; foliage almost black	<i>Cistus</i> ‘Sunset’ rock rose To 2 ft. high, 3-8 ft. wide Deep rose-pink 2 in. flowers with yellow center, spring to early	<i>Helianthemum nummularium</i> ‘Ben Nevis’ sunrose To 6-8 in. tall; 2-3 ft. wide Orange flowers, spring, summer; small leaves usually gray-green
<i>Ajuga reptans</i> ‘Catlin’s Giant’ Catlin’s carpet bugle To 1 ft high, 2-3 ft wide Purple-blue flowers, spring; green leaves with bronze edges.	<i>Coreopsis</i> ‘Jethro Tull’ tickseed To 12 to 15 in. high, 12 to 18 in. wide Golden yellow flowers, spring through summer	<i>Helianthemum nummularium</i> ‘Hartswood Ruby’ sunrose To 6-8 in tall; 18-24 in wide Dark pink flowers, spring, summer; small leaves usually gray-green
<i>Arbutus unedo</i> ‘Oktoberfest’ strawberry bush, tree To 6 to 8 ft. (This is compact form.) Pink flowers and yellow to red fruit fall and winter; leaves dark green	<i>Cotoneaster dammeri</i> ‘Coral Beauty’ bearberry cotoneaster To 8 in high, 8 ft wide White flowers, spring; bright orange-red berries; dark green leaves	<i>Hemerocallis</i> ‘Bitsy’ Bitsy daylily To 1 ft. high and wide Lemon yellow flowers, spring, summer, fall; narrow grass-like foliage
<i>Arctostaphylos edmundsii</i> ‘Carmel Sur’ Carmel Sur manzanita To 3-6 in. high, 12 feet wide Light pink globe-shaped flowers, spring; small medium-green leaves.	<i>Crassula brevifolia</i> crassula To 6 in high, 12 in wide Pink flowers; light green leaves with red edges	<i>Hemerocallis</i> ‘Bouquet of Ruffles’ Bouquet of Ruffles daylily To 1 ft. high and wide Apricot lowers, spring, summer, fall; narrow grassy leaves
<i>Arctostaphylos sp.</i> ‘Emerald Carpet’ manzanita To 1 ft. high; 4-6 ft. wide Tiny pink flowers, spring; small 0.5 in. leaves, dark green all year.	<i>Crassula coccinea</i> ‘Campfire’ crassula To 18 in high, 18 in wide Red or white flowers, summer; brilliant red-orange and yellow leaves	<i>Hemerocallis</i> ‘Cranberry Baby’ dwarf red daylily To 1 ft. high and wide Cranberry red flowers, spring, summer, fall; narrow grassy leaves
<i>Arctotheca calendula</i> capeweed, Cape dandelion To 6 to 12 in tall, 18 in wide Yellow daisy flowers, spring through all year; leaves gray-green	<i>Crassula dubia</i> crassula To 18 in high, 18 in wide White fragrant flowers, summer; silver-gray leaves	<i>Heteromeles arbutifolia</i> toyon, Christmas berry Shrub 6-10 ft.; multi-trunk tree 15-25 ft. White flowers, summer; dark green leaves; bright red berries winter
<i>Armeria</i> ‘Bright Rose’ sea pink, thrift To 2 to 8 in high, 18 in wide Bright rose flowers, spring to summer	<i>Crassula pruinosa</i> crassula To 6 in high, 12 in wide White bell-shaped flowers, spring, summer; light green leaves	<i>Iberis sempervirens</i> candytuft To 12 in tall and wide White flowers, spring; glossy dark green leaves
<i>Armeria alliacea</i> sea pink To 18 in. high and wide Pink flowers, summer; narrow green leaves	<i>Delosperma</i> ‘Fire Spinner’ Fire spinner ice plant To 1-3 in. high, 12-18 in. wide Pink and orange flowers, spring, summer.	<i>Iris</i> (rhizomatous) bearded iris, rhizomatous iris To 4 in to 4 ft tall All colors of flowers; blue-green sword leaves
