<i>Arctostaphylos sp.</i> ‘Emerald Carpet’ manzanita To 1 ft. high; 4-6 ft. wide Tiny pink flowers, spring; small 0.5 in. leaves, dark green all year. *1 if watered Fire 2* Area 2	<i>Crassula coccinea</i> ‘Campfire’ crassula To 18 in high, 18 in wide Red or white flowers, summer; brilliant red-orange and yellow leaves Fire 1 Area 2	<i>Helianthemum</i> ‘The Bride’ sunrose 4 to 6 in. high, 18 to 23 in. wide White flowers, spring to summer Fire 1 Area 3
